

PERSONAL BELONGINGS AND RESOURCE PICK-UP

In order to facilitate the orderly and hygienic pick-up of students' personal belongings and learning resources, we invite parents to use the School Interviews website to arrange a convenient pick up time between the hours of 9:00AM and 3:00PM on Thursday, March 19 or Friday, March 20.

Please go to www.schoolinterviews.ca to book your own pick-up time and enter the code **eaegy**. If you're unable to book online, please call the school so we can book it for you.

One adult family member per family can come to the school at their scheduled time. Please limit the visit to adults only and only one adult per family. They will be greeted at the front entrance by a staff member and directed to the tables set up inside the doors to request the belongings and resources for their child. The items will be brought to the family member at the tables.

Hygiene Protocols

- If you are sick, stay home;
- Maintain social distancing protocols;
- To limit numbers, only one adult family member should be coming to the school;
- To maintain efficiency, please be on time and stick to your 5 minute time slot.

Staff have collected the personal belongings from classrooms and lockers as best they could. If students have opted to switch or share lockers with a classmate and not inform their teachers, you may not get all or your child's belongings or you may get items that do not belong to you. Staff also did their best to remove any perishable items to avoid unwanted science experiments from happening.

Teachers are also in the process of putting resource packages together for those students who may need specific items like books or chromebooks. These packages will also be bagged and turned over to families at the same time.

For those in Band, your instrument will also be waiting for pick up as well.

If your child has library books or other school resources, we do ask they be dropped off at this time.

For those who are quarantined, self-isolating, or otherwise unable to pick up items, please ask family or friends to pick them up for you. If that's not possible, please call the school.

We are still working on a protocol for the refund of dance tickets, field trips, etc. Hopefully we'll have that worked out for you soon.
