Out of a desperate need for playground equipment, we have recently formed the **Friends of Pioneer** School Fundraising Society. The province does not typically allocate funds for schools to build or maintain playground structures. As a





result the existing playground equipment is wearing out and is not being replaced. The school currently only has a small playground of workout equipment that is quickly deteriorating. Unfortunately playground equipment is extremely expensive and without a dedicated team we realized getting the much needed equipment would be nearly impossible. We have put together a very eager team that has hit the ground running, hoping we can assist the school in their goal of revitalizing the playground for the students. Playgrounds usually have a price tag of about \$100,000 and up.
