Items of Note

Pioneer has what is referred to as a "**closed campus**." Which means that students can only leave school grounds if signed-out and picked up by a responsible adult. That responsible adult would the parent/legal guardian or someone they designate. This is for the safety & security of our young students and means they cannot leave without clear parental consent.
