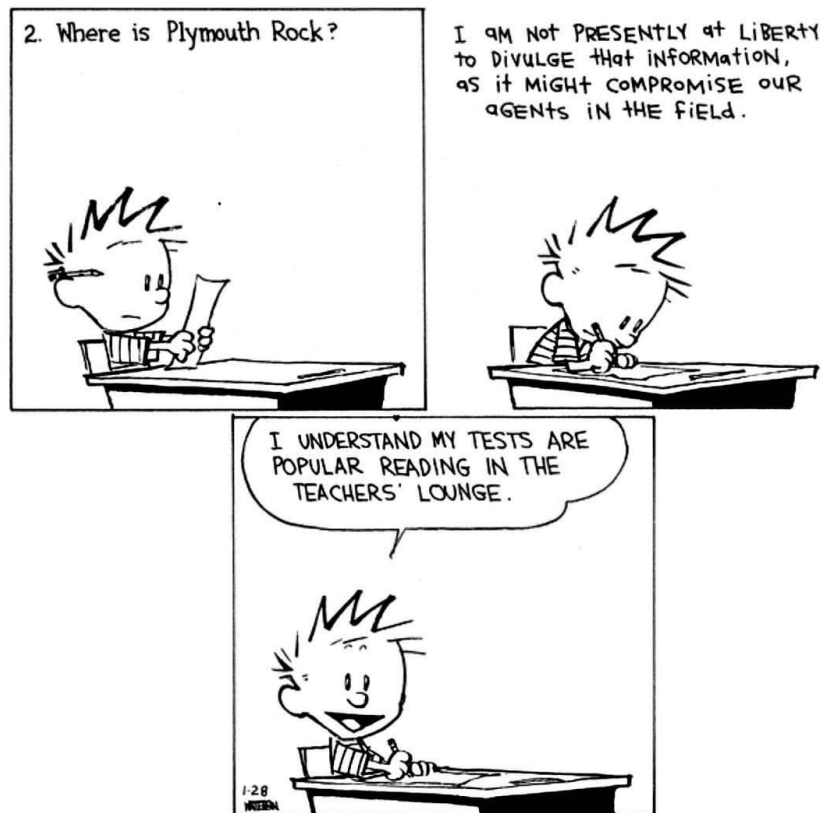
Dates to Remember
