Items of Note

The most recent changes to pandemic protocols include:

- Masking
 - Students are no longer required to wear masks in schools or on buses;
 - Adults are still required to wear masks in schools and on buses; and
 - We must create an atmosphere of respect for those that choose to wear them.
- No limits on spectators for school sports and performance activities. Masks are still required at extracurricular events for spectators older than 12 years of age.
- The [daily checklist](#) is still in place, which means students and staff must stay home when sick.
- Ten days isolation is still required for those testing positive. Individuals who are vaccinated and asymptomatic, can return to school on day 6, but they must wear a mask from day 6 to day 10. Unvaccinated individuals must stay home for the full 10 days. This includes both students and staff.
- No quarantine is required for close contacts, but continue to monitor and consider regular rapid testing if you are a household close contact.
- Grade 6 cohorting continues until at least March 1.
