-Finance: Carrying forward close to 20,000 forward.

-Staffing for next year: Going from 8 EA's to 3. Only the most complex students will have EA's next year. We are in the process of applying for Jordan's principle for one student for next year. Going down one FTE teacher for next year. One grade 7 teacher will be moved to grade 8. Three teachers in grade 6, three in grade 7 and four in grade 8 plus two french immersion teachers.

-School education plan next year: The overall theme will be fostering positive relationships. Number fluency and vocabulary will also be focused on. The teacher growth aspect will be how we assess writing.

-This week we are focusing on grade 5 student transitions into grade 6.

-We will host ERE and Lochearn at the school on separate days this week to tour the school and complete an orientation program.

-There will be a parent orientation meeting coming up soon.

-PAT's for grade 6's are next week.

-The grade 7 Drumheller field trip is coming up

-On the last day of school there will be a grade 8 farewell. The grade 8's will have their own barbeque. There will be a dance on the last day.
