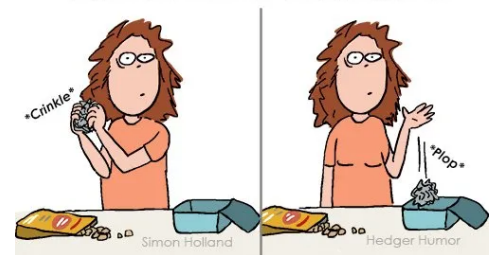
First week of school:
