

## **Items of Note**

**Absentee rates** have been increasing in recent years. On any given day, 13% of Pioneer students are not in school. That's an average of 40 students missing every day. Each day missed is a day of content missed. This means the child requires additional work to get & stay caught up. When a child misses 2 or more days of school per month, it is categorized as "chronic absenteeism." Two days per month may not seem like much, but it adds up and results in decreased levels of achievement and increased levels of frustration for the child. While we do not want sick kids coming to school, we do encourage parents to consider the long term consequences of absenteeism.
